

Easington / Horden E /NE

Easington / Horden

Direction: Easterly

Location: NZ 448421 Post code SR8 3SX Emergency 3 words keep,cone.every (take off)

Access: From the A19 take the A1086 sign posted Easingto/Horden ,right at the roundabout ,left at the next one ,first right into refuse recycling (SR8 3SX), follow down to railway bridge.
Park before the bridge (**Small Red Circle**). Walk under bridge and turn right to take off approx. ¼ mile (**Blue line**)

Height: 110 ft.

Length: 200 m between gaps, but possible to fly 5 miles either way

Description: Industrial coastline with a grass bank take-off.

Suitability: Subject to conditions, all levels of flier.

Site Rules

There are no specific rules relating to this site. Just remember to follow the country code, fly sensibly and keep a look out for members of the public.

Take-off: Where suitable.

Fairly benign site ,always a bottom landing up to the headlands at Horden point (right) and Blackhall Rocks (right) even when tide is in

Landings: Anywhere

Bottom: The beach is OK if the tide is low enough.

Comments: Beware when going beyond the headlands mentioned above, whatever the state of the tide, bottom landing will be hazardous or there may be no bottom landing.

A unplanned landing in the sea is usually fatal
